2. For what purpose do we process your personal data?

The data we collect through all our services are used to provide, maintain, protect and improve these services, develop new services and ensure the protection of Social Wifi and our users. We may also use this data to send you commercial or promotional information that may be of your interest, satisfaction surveys or statistics of services provided by Social Wifi as well as our customers (the business you are visiting and gives you access).

3. How long will we keep your data?

For 5 years or when they are no longer necessary for the purpose for which they were collected.

4. What is the legitimacy for the processing of your data?

We indicate the legal basis for the treatment of your data:

- Consent of the interested party: REGULATION (EU) 2016/679, of April 27, 2016 of the European Parliament, and of the Council relative to the Protection of the physical persons with regard to the treatment of their personal data.
- Law 34/2002, of July 11, on Services of the Information Society and Electronic Commerce; Law 56/2007 of December 28 on Measures to Promote the Information Society; Royal Legislative Decree 1/2007, of November 16, which approves the Revised Text of the General Law for the Defense of Consumers and Users.

5. To which recipients will your data be communicated?

We will provide your personal data to our subsidiaries or to organizations and other trusted third parties because they carry out their treatment on behalf of Social Wifi following our instructions, in accordance with our Privacy Policy and adopt the appropriate measures to guarantee the confidentiality and security of this data.

To continue offering the free Wi-Fi service, we may share your data with our clients for direct marketing purposes, as well as companies in sectors such as: leisure, marketing, telecommunications, consumer, financial, automotive, energy and water.

We can also share your data with partners, such as TripAdvisor because they can send requests for reviews and impressions of the visit.

At the request of our clients (the business that you are visiting and provides you with access) we can also transfer your data to companies such as MailChimp also for direct marketing purposes.

Legal grounds:

- comply with any requirement provided in the applicable legislation or regulations or meet any requirement of an administrative or judicial body,
- comply with the provisions of the current Conditions of Use, including the investigation of possible infractions, detect or prevent any fraud or technical or security incident or deal with them in another way, protect the rights, assets or Social Security Wifi, of our users or the general public to the extent required or permitted by applicable law.

6. Data transfers to third countries

Data transfers to third countries are not foreseen.

7. What are your rights when you provide us with your data?

Anyone has the right to obtain confirmation on whether or not SOCIAL WIFI, SL is treating personal data that concerns them.

Interested persons have the right to access their personal data, as well as to request the rectification of inaccurate data or, where appropriate, request its deletion when, among other reasons, the data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected. You also have the right to the portability of your data.

In certain circumstances, the interested parties may request the limitation of the processing of their data, in which case we will only keep them for the exercise or defense of claims.

In certain circumstances and for reasons related to their particular situation, the interested parties may object to the processing of their data. In this case, SOCIAL WIFI, SL will stop processing the data, except for compelling legitimate reasons, or the exercise or defense of possible claims.

When the sending of commercial communications is carried out using the legitimate interest of the person in charge as a legal basis, the interested party may oppose the processing of their data for that purpose.

If you have given your consent for a specific purpose, you have the right to withdraw the consent granted at any time, without affecting the legality of the treatment based on the consent prior to its withdrawal.

In the event that you feel your rights are violated with regard to the protection of your personal data, especially when you have not obtained satisfaction in the exercise of your rights, you can file a claim with the competent Data Protection Control Authority through from its website: www.agpd.es.
